



Aerohub/Enterprise Zones

[Enterprise Zones](#) represent an opportunity to contribute to the pro-growth agenda.

The Aerohub Enterprise Zone in Cornwall can accommodate new growth via inward investment in two key sectors Space and Aerospace to two nationally important assets Cornwall Airport Newquay and Goonhilly Earth Station. The sites have an attractive combination of incentives, development space, existing infrastructure and an excellent aviation/space environment, both EZ locations are well placed to compete against some of the other major inward investment locations in Europe.

Aerohub at Cornwall Airport Newquay is England's only aerospace focused Enterprise Zone with significant development land and access to operational environments. Goonhilly Earth Station allows Cornwall work across Southern England LEPs and with industry to grow a space industrial cluster

Spaceport Cornwall as a part of the EZ programme is a high profile opportunity to realise the full ambition of creating an influential new Satellite technology based space cluster in the UK. The Spaceport will maximise the sector potential for the UK and southern England. We are the only site in England able to offer the potential to capture this new technology as it develops and matures.

The LEP led a successful competitive bid to create an [Enterprise Zone](#) around Cornwall Airport Newquay in 2011 (extended to include GES in 2016) encouraging businesses within the aerospace and space industry to locate to Cornwall and spawning opportunities for other supporting businesses.

The Aerohub Enterprise Zone Board is a Sub Group of the LEP. It reports regularly to each LEP Board meeting. Its membership is detailed in Appendix 6.
